- Name and address of arena
- Host club responsibility to get the criminal record checks (including vulnerable sector) for billets
- Billets pick up skaters at 10:00 pm at the end of autograph signing following the show
- Billets bring skaters back to the arena the next morning approximately from 8:00am to 9:00am.
- Billets provide a safe and friendly environment for skaters
- 2 – 3 skaters per home. No skater will be billeted alone
- There will be approximately 30 skaters in need of billeting
- List of billets must be sent into the Sask. Section Office prior to Friday, March 8th, 2019
- Advertise for the Municipal Hail Insurance “Stars on Ice” Road Show.
- Sask. Section will send posters for the Road Show to host clubs

- Host club needs to provide a shipping location for the Municipal Hail Insurance “Stars on Ice” Road Show posters. Preferably at a location someone will be available to accept delivery.

Information Regarding Show

- Local skaters performing solo’s in Road Show need to be involved at the end of practice ice time from 4:00 pm to 4:15pm.
- 4:15 pm FLOOD
- Supply ice for CanSkate Session 4:30 pm to 5:15 pm.
- Supply ice at 5:15 pm to 6:00 pm is HPT Director to facilitate free skate session.
- Supply ice for Synchro teams participating in Road Show from 6:00 pm to 6:30 pm.
- Club coaches and Program Assistants need to be involved in CanSkate session.
- Host club provides a hot supper for Team Saskatchewan after practice but before show: 5:00 pm to 6:30 pm.
- **The Sunday, March 10th show will start 30 minutes earlier.**
- **Host clubs can have their club skaters perform solos, duets, STAR group numbers, and CanSkate group numbers in the “2019 Municipal Hail Saskatchewan Stars on Ice”. We will have ~25 performances from the touring skaters. This leaves you with up to 10 registered club numbers you can have in the program. We do not want to have the show too long.**
- **Host club skaters can only perform in one show number.**

- Freshly flooded ice prior the show.
- Flood the ice during intermission.
- A brief “Grand Finale” will be after the Team Members have finished their “Grand Finale”.
- Host club provides a light snack following the show.
- Take admission at the door. Please remember to provide a money float/money supply so change can be given at the onset of taking admission. The amount of the float should be taken off the total sales at the end of the night from gate receipts. A cheque for the gate should be given to Skater Development Chairperson – Carla Laevens.
- Show starts at 6:30 pm on Sunday, March 10th.
- Show starts at 7:00 pm on March 11th, 12th, and 13th and done around 9:30pm.
- Host club provides an area with table and chairs for autograph signing following the show.
- Clubs can sell 50/50 tickets, door prizes, or other promotions to raise money for the club.
