



Club Coach Grant

Skate Canada - Saskatchewan is offering grants to encourage Club coaching candidates to complete their certification and continue to coach in Saskatchewan.

Individuals may apply for a grant of \$150 upon receiving Club Coach “Trained” Status. Applications must be received within 90 days of completion.

Eligibility for Club Coach “Trained” Status:

- Attend the three (3) day NCCP Club course including on-ice assessment
- Complete the class assignments successfully
- Register as a Skate Canada Professional Coach
- Successfully complete the NCCP Club Coach Trained Evaluation Portfolio which includes two (2) technical lessons. To be completed within one (1) year from achieving an “In-Training” status.

Individuals may apply for a grant of \$200 upon receiving Club Coach “Certified” Status. Applications must be received within 90 days of completion.

Eligibility for Club Coach “Certified” Status:

- Successfully complete the NCCP Club Certified Portfolio which consists of a complete video analysis of the coaches CanSkate program in action. To be completed within three (3) years from being Club Coach In-Training.
