Competitive Skater

- Must be a registered Skate Canada member in Saskatchewan for the current season.
- Compete for the Saskatchewan Section in the current season at a Sectionals.
- No age restrictions
- Must provide one (1) of the following record of attendance at a Canadian Post-Secondary institution or Distance Learning
 - Copy of tuition payments
 - Transcript
 - If you wish to use other documentation, please contact the Section Office before hand to determine if it is acceptable.
- Indication of training (choose one (1) of the following):
 - Provide a short video
 - Record of transaction for purchase of ice time
 - Record of payment to a coach
- Provide a short summary (up to 500 words) as to your involvement and commitment to the sport and why you feel you deserve post-secondary grant.

Note: Any applications submitted without all supporting documentation will not be considered.

Deadline for online application is **December 31st at 4:00 PM CST.** Online applications posted on www.skatecanadasaskatchewan.com under Forms/Grants.
