PROGRAM POLICIES

Skate Bank

In order to be eligible to receive a skate bank, clubs must be members in good standing.

Priority will be given to Skate Canada - Saskatchewan applications as follows:

- Skate Canada clubs will be given first priority;
- Areas with natural ice will have priority in December, January and February. Areas with artificial ice will have priority in October, November and March;
- Schools/groups offering CanSkate at School
- Schools/groups interested in trying skating for the first time

In all cases we anticipate full usage of this equipment for a number of different clubs, schools and groups.

Policies:

- Clubs/Schools/Groups may will receive the skate bank for a two-week period;
- Each club/school/group must forward the skate bank to the next user group on time;
- Groups pay for the shipping costs when the equipment is received;
- All forms must be completed properly and sent into the Skate Canada - Saskatchewan office on time;
- User Groups will be charged for loss or damage to equipment.
