Road Show

Road Show promotes the benefits of the sport of figure skating to members of Saskatchewan clubs, their community and the surrounding area.

Activities organized for a Road Show are meant to be motivational to the existing members and encouraging for future club members. Some of the activities are as follows:

- Team Saskatchewan members from the High Performance and Competitive teams along with local skaters perform in "SASKATCHEWAN STARS ON ICE". Local skater involvement may include performing solos, duets or group numbers.
- The soloists and duets will also do a finale number with Team Saskatchewan which is fun and very easy to learn.
- Program Coordinator and/or High Performance Director conducts a group lesson with local Competitive and STARSkate skaters as well as those performing in the ice show.
- The Program Coordinator and Team members also participate in a host club's CanSkate session (45 minutes) in conjunction with the club's CanSkate coaches.
- Clubs chosen for the Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday; Team members will make presentations at local schools and be available to meet local media when time permits.
- Clubs chosen to host the Road Show are based on dates chosen by clubs, locations, and travelling route. We try to go to areas that the Road Show has not been before.

The Road Show activities take approximately 6 hours and are run during the day and in the evening. Clubs may choose from the following dates: **Sun. March 10th – Mon. March 11th – Tues. March 12th – Wed. March 13th, 2019**

COST TO CLUBS: Clubs must be able to supply 6 hours of ice-time and a hot meal before the "Ice Show". Most clubs try to use their regular day of skating. Billeting for approximately 24 Team members will be needed on the Sunday, Monday and Tuesday nights. Please note all billets must have a criminal record check (including vulnerable sector). We also ask the host club to provide a music player and someone to sing "O Canada" at the show.

PROMOTION: This along with other duties will be explained once your application has been accepted. The Skater Development Committee does most of the planning and sends out a press release to local media as well as posters to the hosting club for advertising in the community and surrounding area.

Hosting the Road Show is a great way to finish a skating season. It's a great opportunity to promote figure skating in your community. Clubs who have hosted the Road Show in the past say it is extremely motivational for their skaters. To help cover the cost of the Road Shows, Skate Canada - Saskatchewan keeps the admission fees from the "Ice Show". Clubs are encouraged to do fundraising activities in conjunction with the Ice Show to help offset their expenses.
