Recipients of this award have demonstrated the enthusiasm and desire to grow skating in Saskatchewan allowing for continued success for the club both on and off the ice.

Online Nominations for the Volunteer Spotlight of the Month would be due on the 1st of each month from September to March. The Section Office or selection committee would determine two (2) recipients to be featured through social media and eventually on the website. Recipients of the Volunteer Spotlight of the Month would receive a certificate.

Each club would be “awarded” a Volunteer Spotlight Award to be presented to one (1) recipient at the Club Carnival as chosen by the Selection Committee. The recipient would receive a certificate.

From these nominations, one (1) recipient per Region would be chosen to receive the Regional Volunteer Spotlight Recognition Award presented at the Skate Canada – Saskatchewan Awards Luncheon held in conjunction with the Annual General Meeting OR at their respective Regional Spring Meeting.

Members of the Section Board of Directors, Regional Coordinators, Regional Coaching Representatives and Skate Canada Professional Coaching Members are not eligible to receive this award.
